

Current Capacity



- NJDOT owns 19 Park & Ride facilities throughout the State totaling approximately 3940 commuter parking spaces.
- Additionally NJDOT leases 12 Park & Ride facilities from private owners, totaling approximately 1,680 commuter parking spaces.
- There are about 475 Park & Ride facilities throughout the State, both publically and privately owned totaling approximately 107,100 commuter spaces.


