#### **Charges dismissed** in bomb scare case at Newark Airport

Newark Airport for allegedly carrying a fake bomb in his luggage has had the charges thrown out by the Essex Coun-ty Prosecutor's Office, officials said.

Alon Feldman, 50, saw charges of creating false public alarm and interference with transportation dismissed by the Prosecutor's Office, said Katherine Carter, a spokeswoman for the office.

"Upon further investigation, we determined that what appeared to be a bomb was an inert bomb, meaning it could not explode," Carter said. "And that he was a defense contractor and it was part of a sales demonstration." On Sept. 4, Feldman was stopped at minal C in the airport when a scan of

Feldman told authorities he was on his way from Israel to training for X-ray detection techniques in Florida. The device found in his luggage was to be used for a demonstration and had all the components of a bomb except the explosive element, according to court documents.

Feldman's attorney Matt Beck had maintained that no crime had been committed and was sure the Prosecu tor's Office would realize so upon further investigation.

"As we said from the outset of this matter, Alon Feldman is a legitimate businessman who committed no crime," Beck said in a statement. "We were confident that once the Prosecu tor's Office had time to review the facts and circumstances of the event, it would come to the same conclusion.
