

Eric Schwarz is the Research Librarian for the New Jersey Department of Transportation. He is a member of the National Transportation Knowledge Network. He also serves on a Transportation Research Board subcommittee that reviews terms for its thesaurus, ensuring a common and consistent language between producers and users of transportation information. Schwarz has worked as a librarian at multiple public and academic libraries. He formerly was a researcher at Dow Jones, and a reporter and copy editor for several newspapers in New Jersey. He has two degrees from Rutgers University: a master's degree in library and information science, and a bachelor's degree in journalism/mass media and English.

The NJDOT Research Library provides knowledge resources to transportation professionals in New Jersey so that they can plan, design, construct, and maintain a high-quality transportation system.
