



It has been recommended that we procure professional (training) services internally through our Division of Procurement and/or through the NJ Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJDOL).

Partnerships

We will be partnering with the NJDOL's Workforce Development Services.

<u>Advantages</u>: NJDOL's business includes procuring training services and preparing individuals for apprenticeship programs; and can customize transportation related training to include counseling and prescreening services for NJDOT. <u>NOTE</u>: The Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP) no longer has oversight of transportation mega projects; therefore, NJDOT will be working independently on outreach and other related activities.





Contractor Compliance unit collaboration efforts continues:

- The last Construction Contracting Industry meeting was held in June 2025. Topics continue to focus on:
 - ✓ Disadvantage Businesses
 - ✓ Unions & Apprenticeship Programs
 - ✓ Aging of the workforce and union members
 - Methodologies to increase membership: Spreading awareness on the opportunities for employment and advancement with the highway construction industry
 - Hosting a dual open house for individuals interested in working on NJDOT's construction projects internally with NJDOT or externally with NJDOT's construction contractors.
